

Background

General Responsibilities

The Deputy Chief of Party (DCOP) directly reports to the COP in activity implementation and management. The DCOP will take leadership and oversight of the activity in the absence of the COP. This position is responsible for coordinating the various technical experts and aligns them to program activities.

Specific Responsibilities

1. Ensure that compliance measures of the required protocols are developed, trainings are conducted, and smooth field implementation is underway
2. Conduct data quality assessments and ensure supportive supervision is regularly conducted
3. Improve routine health information system strengthening – including improvement of malaria data quality and use through the routine health information system
4. Build upon and expand the malaria surveillance and response system
5. Work closely with partners and undertake all operational research activities which are submitted and approved by the National Institute for Medical Research (NIMR)
6. Other duties as assigned by the COP and Akros

Minimum Qualifications

- A Masters level degree or above in Public Health, Epidemiology or related fields from an accredited higher education institution. (An Epidemiologist, Malariologist/Public Health Expert preferred)
- 8+ hands-on experience in disease surveillance, programmatic surveillance and malaria surveillance – candidates with direct experience in Tanzania preferred.
- Strong understanding in advanced database and statistical analysis software (SAS, STATA, Epi Info, SPSS, etc.)
- Strong background in using DHIS2, HMIS – ideally within the Tanzanian context
- Ability to lead technical teams
- Strong communication skills – excellent written and verbal English skills are required.

Location and Term

This position is based in multiple locations in and is open to international and local candidates. All positions are contingent upon successful award of the USAID Tanzania Malaria Surveillance and Monitoring contract to Akros.
