



Job Announcement: Multiple Positions in Tanzania

Akros is a cutting-edge organization that establishes data-driven systems that improve the health and wellbeing of disadvantaged communities. We pride ourselves in our ground-level knowledge of the health systems where we work, and our ability to provide novel, lasting solutions implemented in developing regions.

The anticipated USAID Tanzania Case Management and Surveillance Activity (\$25-50 million) is aimed at supporting the Government of Tanzania (GOT) to reduce the burden of malaria and to move towards the long-term goal of malaria elimination. We are currently seeking qualified candidates for the following positions, which will be based in Dar es Salaam and/or Dodoma, Tanzania and there is a preference for local candidates. All positions are contingent upon the successful award of the USAID Tanzania Case Management and Surveillance Activity to Akros. Anticipated project start date is September 2022.

Chief of Party: The Chief of Party (COP) will provide the overall strategic direction and technical oversight for the USAID Tanzania Case Management and Surveillance Activity and will also have the primary responsibility for liaising with USAID, NMCP, ZAMEP, PORALG and other stakeholders in country. As part of overseeing and ensuring successful program implementation, the COP is expected to set the technical vision and strategy along with carrying out management oversight for the project. Previous experience serving in leadership positions for projects of similar size and scope is a requirement.

Malaria Technical Director: This position is for a senior, experienced malaria expert with a detailed understanding of the latest malaria research and global best practices for malaria interventions. S/he is responsible for providing high-level strategic leadership, guidance, oversight and supervision of the design, implementation, and monitoring of high-impact interventions to support the implementation of activities under this activity. S/he will have relevant technical expertise and experience in the areas of malaria case management and surveillance, a solid professional reputation, and program management expertise.

Surveillance, Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist: The Surveillance, Monitoring & Evaluation (SME) Specialist will support the NMCP and ZAMEP at all levels with state of the art advice and guidance on the implementation of approaches to strengthen, harmonize, or expand their respective malaria surveillance and response systems. S/he will determine the technical vision and system design to facilitate visualization, analysis, and use of data with particular attention to district and community levels. The Specialist should have a strong technical understanding of intensified surveillance in geographic areas approaching malaria elimination and be fluent in HMIS interoperability frameworks and best practices.
